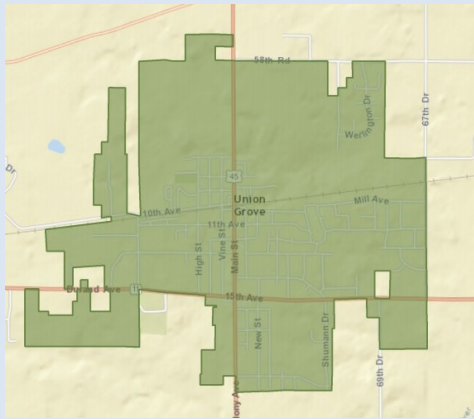


Union Grove Snapshot

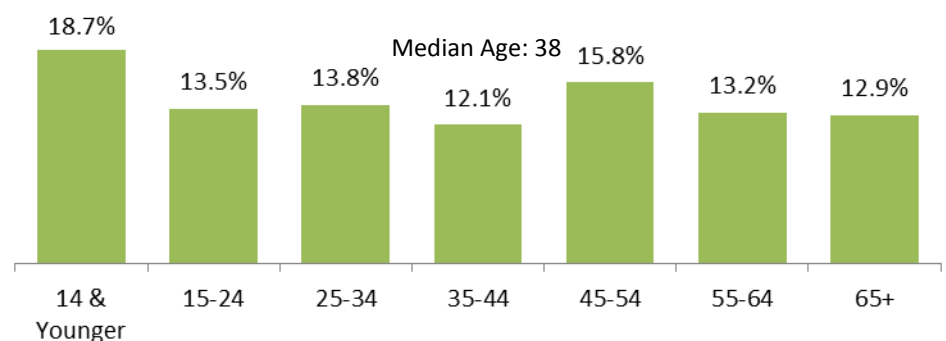

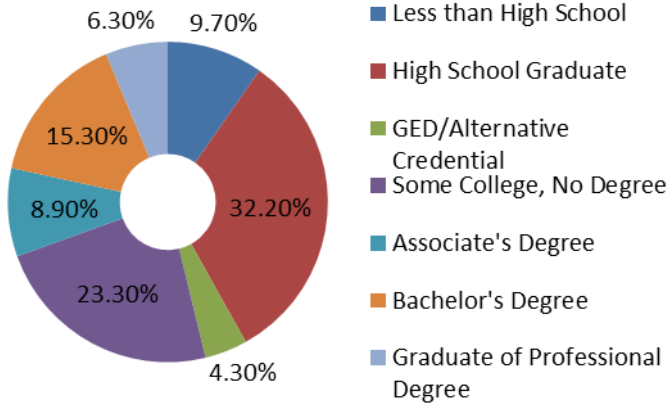

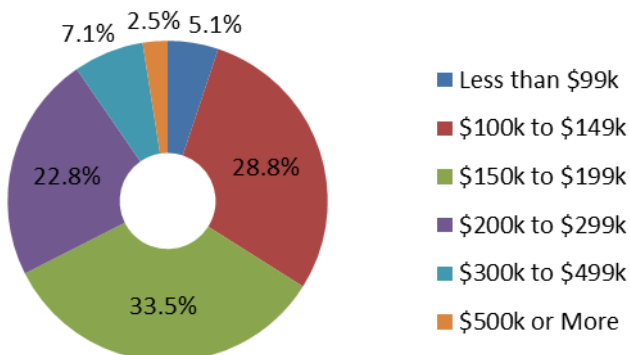

Also served by three smaller airports: John H. Batten Field in Racine (14 miles north-east) and Sylvania Airport in Sturtevant (5 miles east).

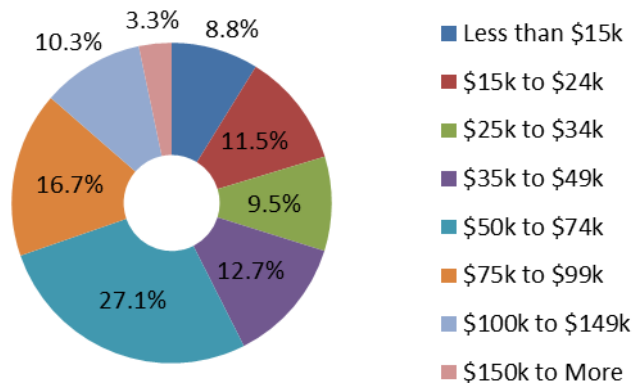


Sea Port Services
